April 2, 2009

After breakfast at the Imperial Hotel in Tokyo, we will set out for our motor coach trip to Mt. Fuji. Our first stop will be at the 5th Station of Mt. Fuji followed by the Fuji Visitor Center and then Hakone. This afternoon we will have the opportunity of viewing Lake Ashi from both the water and the air! After our boat cruise, we will take the Mt. Komagatake Ropeway for an Ariel view. Lake Ashi is a crater lake that lies on the southwest wall of the caldera of Mount Hakone, a complex volcano. The lake is known for its views of Mt. Fuji and its numerous hot springs. We will then head to the beautiful Fuji Lake Hotel to check in and rest before dinner at the hotel. The evening is yours to enjoy the hotel and baths.

The Fuji Lake Hot Spring source is 1500m beneath the earth, and is registered by the Environment Agency. The Japanese cypress Bath and Large-Lava Garden Bath are open 24 hours a day, and are located in the fresh air outside. Besides the open air baths, there is a big main bath, herb sauna bath and Jacuzzi which will provide you with soothing, quiet comfort.
